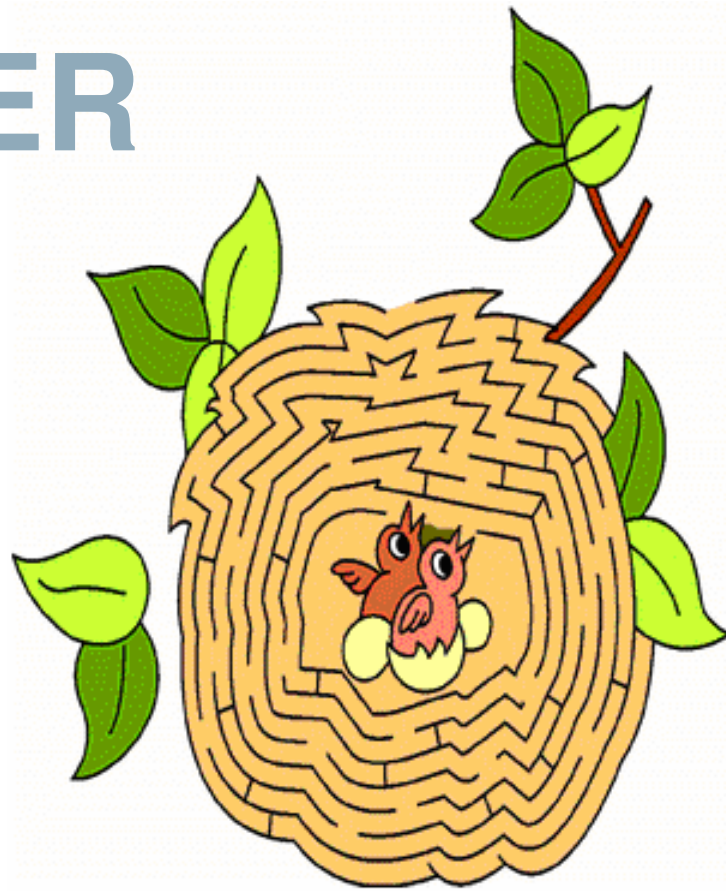

fab FOOD

Tuna patties

Serves 2

4 medium potatoes (cooked and mashed)

420g tin of tuna (drained)

2 eggs

1 onion (chopped)



Method

Mix all together and roll into balls. Heat a small amount of oil in a frying pan and place tuna patties in and slightly flatten out. Cook until golden brown and then place on a paper towel to drain excess oil. Serve with a salad or vegetables anytime of the year.

NEWS

Our Development Team has been very busy since we sent you the last newsletter. Their hard work will help ease the affordable housing shortage.

One of the major new developments is on a landmark site in Northbridge.

Designed to deliver affordable housing close to essential amenities, this development on the corner of Zempilas Road and Newcastle Street will house key workers above retail and office tenancies at street level.

A five-storey hostel comprising 44 single bed units will also be built at the rear of the site. There will be a café which will provide employment and training to our tenants.

The development is expected to be completed in June 2011.

We are also taking on many new properties all over the greater Perth area. This includes 200 properties in the areas of Ellenbrook, Midland and the northern corridor. We will have these by 2012.
