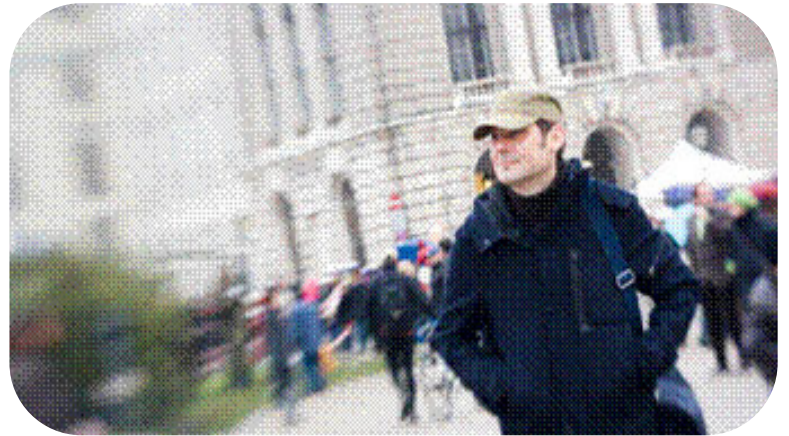

Lodging & Shared Housing is just part of what we offer. It provides much needed affordable accommodation for those entering into a 'housing career' with the aim of moving into single independent housing if residents so wish to do so.

Lodging Services has **335 beds** in total. This is made up of **six lodging houses** consisting of **103 beds** in the Metro area and **185 beds** in the Fremantle area at Hampton Road. We also have **nine shared houses** with an average of five beds totaling **47** in the Perth Metro area.

All residents of Lodging Services who wish to further their 'housing career' should be on the Department of Housing (formerly known as HOMESWEST) Waitlist.
