

Street to Home Program

The Street to Home Program provides individualised case management for residents of Foundation Housing lodges who need support to address their issues and improve their circumstances.

Who is Street to Home?

We're a team of Case Workers who assist you to find the support you'd like so that you can take steps to solve problems that are making it hard for you to stay in your accommodation. We'll work with you to develop better options for your future.

If you agree, we'll help you plan and support you to help yourself.

How does Street to Home work?

Your Lodging Coordinator can refer you to us if they see you are becoming at risk of not being able to stay in your accommodation. You can also talk to us directly about how we might be able to assist and support you.

What do we do?

Once we understand your needs we use our extensive knowledge of local support agencies to help you access the assistance you've decided you want.

What is your commitment?

Your commitment is an agreement to work with us to address your issues. This includes attending appointments we arrange for you.

You'll also be asked to attend arranged appointments with us to talk about how we can support you to plan and achieve your goals.

What type of support can you access through Street to Home?

You can expect the following assistance:

- An individualised plan to address the issues that are causing you problems in your life.
- To be connected to appropriate support services for your issues, so that you can build a better future.
- Help to plan, manage and improve your overall wellbeing.
- The chance to discuss any other concerns you have and that we'll work to assist you with those concerns.
- Guidance and support to ensure you can sustain your lodging residency.

Facts about Street to Home:

- We'll work with you for about 6 months. A little longer if necessary.
- We provide an individual, private and confidential support service.
- Our commitment is to support you to achieve your goals.
