

Committee of Residents and Tenants (CORT)

WHAT IS THE CORT?

The Committee of Residents and Tenants (CORT) is a resident and tenant-led group that provides a forum for you to give feedback to help improve the way Foundation Housing services are delivered to create safe, secure, sustainable and affordable housing.

The CORT meets every two months. Residents and tenants from regional areas are encouraged to be involved and will be provided with support.

WHAT DOES THE CORT DO?

As part of the CORT, you can:

- Provide feedback on FHL policies, procedures and programs.
- Raise broad issues around policy and service delivery directly to FHL.
- Provide feedback to FHL as to how to engage and communicate issues of broad interest to tenants and residents.

WHY SHOULD I JOIN THE CORT?

- Have your voice and ideas heard.
- Get involved in the community and interact with others.
- Make a positive difference for other tenants and residents.
- Develop new skills (e.g. cultural training)

WHO CAN BE A CORT MEMBER?

Any Foundation Housing tenant or lodge resident can apply to join the CORT. Carers of Foundation Housing tenants can also apply. The CORT is looking for members who:

- Are able to participate effectively either in person or remotely in formal meeting settings.
- Can demonstrate respect for diverse viewpoints.
- Can contribute ideas and suggestions to improve service delivery.
- Can work constructively with other tenants and residents and FHL representatives.
